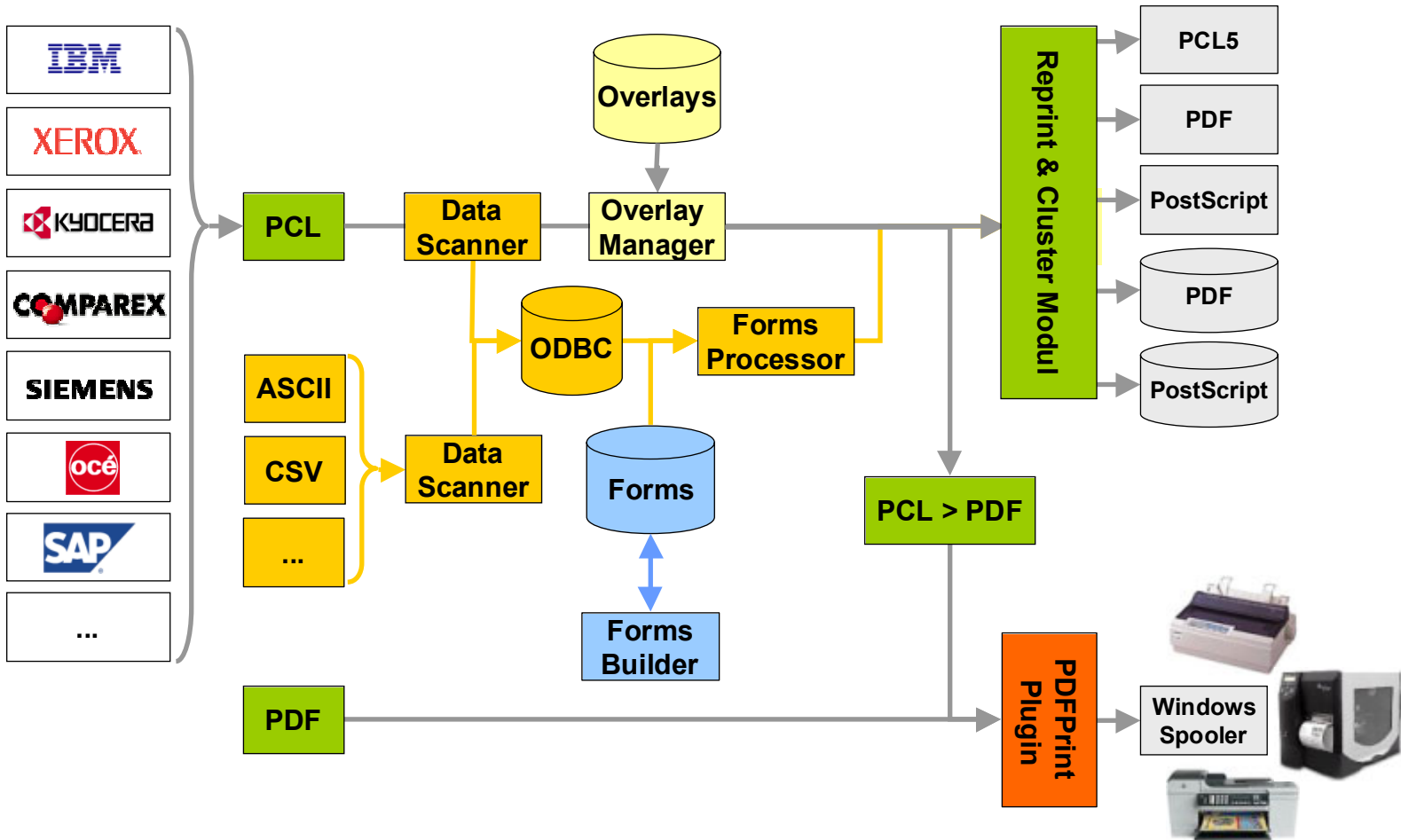
Problem And Solution

Mercury is in versatile use at customers to process print jobs in PCL or PDF format. Even when Mercury does a good job here, there is always a PCL or PDF compatible printer required. Other printers as e.g. Zebra label printers, inkjet or impact printers, which do not understand PCL or PDF are ignored.

The solution:

With the new PDFPrint plugin for Mercury, arbitrary printing data streams may be sent to any printer, using the printer's own driver. PDF files of course also may be passed directly.

Conclusion

- With the new PDFPrint plugin for Mercury every printer, which until now was incompatible with Mercury, can be integrated into the Mercury workflow, too.
- Special printers as e.g. for barcode and labels may be integrated using their own printer driver.
- Applications producing IPDS, X-Metacode, Prescribe, Océ FOL or other not standardised data formats, now can send their output to any printer.
- No matter if laser, ink, thermo or impact, by using the corresponding printer driver, each printer can become part of Mercury's workflow.
